

Overnight ride staying in the Whinny Acres Bed & Breakfast home.

Come see a little peace of heaven, here in the grey county of Ontario. This area is well known as a vacation spot in the winter for the down hill skiing and the summers for the many lakes for fishing, swimming and boating. On our overnight stay we will touch on what this area has to offer.

Day 1: .Arrive at Whinny Acres, in Priceville at 1:00 p.m. where you will meet your guides and get well acquainted with your horse, before heading out on the trails to the Saugeen River. On this ride you will ride up on hilltops with scenic views and valleys, crossing over farmers field to the Saugeen River. Here you will ride up the River before starting back to Whinny Acres for a hearty dinner. After dinner enjoy a dip in the swimming pool or soaking in the hot tub under the stars

Day 2: Wake up to a big country breakfast and be ready for the trails at 9:00 a.m. for a full day of riding in numerous types of forests, and terrain then enjoying your time swimming with your horse.

Camping with your horse, Getaway Adventures

Overnight, Two Day or Three Day

Whether a weekend get-a-way or a break in the week, you will find this to be time well spend discovering Ontario. This ride takes you close to the Beaver Valley, where you will be riding high inclines and looking out over the country side.

You will experience riding up the Saugeen River, River crossings, swimming with your horse, and numerous varieties of forests and terrain.

Overnight Trek:

Arrive at Whinny Acres, in Priceville at 1:00 p.m. where you will meet your guides and get well acquainted with your horse. When all the belongings and gear is loaded up for the overnight trip we will head out over the valley to the Saugeen River, where you will see the scenic country side. We should arrive at the campsite at 5:00 p.m., where we will set up camp for the night. After enjoying dinner cooked over the fire, and the horses are settled in for the night, we can all have a relaxing evening sitting around the fire before heading to bed to get plenty of rest for the full day of riding and swimming with your horse. (\$255.00 per person, double occupancy, Canadian funds, includes taxes.)

Two Day Trek:

Arrive at Whinny Acres at 7:00 p.m., where you will enjoy a peaceful evening getting settled in. You may wish to relax under the stars in the hot tub and take a dip in the pool, preparing for your full day of riding in the morning. After a hardy breakfast, the horses are gathered up, so that we can be on the trails by 10:00 a.m. We will head out towards the Saugeen River, where we will cross over, and make our way through farmlands, logging roads and the Saugeen Conservation where we will set up camp for the night. On our second day of riding we will have a full day of exploring the dense forest, stopping for lunch at the Lake for a swim with your horse before heading back to Whinny Acres. (\$350.00 per person, double occupancy, Canadian Funds, includes taxes)

Three Day Trek:

On this ride you will be traveling the same terrain as the two day ride with the middle day spent traveling along the old rail trail into Durham for ice cream. (\$400.00 per person, double occupancy, Canadian Funds, includes taxes)

Day 1: Arrive at Whinny Acres at 7:00 p.m., where you will enjoy a peaceful evening getting settled in. You may wish to relax under the stars in the hot tub and take a dip in the pool, or sit by the bon fire, preparing for your full day of riding in the morning.

Day 2: After a hardy breakfast, the horses are gathered up, so that we can be on the trails by 10:00 a.m. We will head out towards the Saugeen River, where we will cross over, and make our way through farmlands, logging roads and the Saugeen Conservation reaching the Black Lake, where we will set up camp for the night.

Day 3: Wake up to the horses rustling and whinnying for breakfast, anxious to get out on the trails. Today we have a full day of exploring the dense forest and wildlife before heading back to Whinny Acres.

After saying goodbye to your horses and rounding up all your belongings you will depart from Whinny Acres around 4:00 p.m..

Man Tracker

New Adventure for 2009.

Do you think you are as good as the Man Tracker, or would you like to out smart the Man Tracker.

You can choose to be the Man Tracker or the Prey, here at Whinny Acres.

In conjunction with the Saugeen Conservation, Grey County Forests, and many private property owners, we have found a couple of low traffic locations to host our own Man Tracker weekends. Although it will be on a smaller scale, we believe it will be great practice and fun way to see how you would fare up with the Man Tracker T.V. Show.

When booking you may choose whether you would like to be the Man Tracker or the Prey, or stay for a double header and be both.

On your first night of arrival, you will be set up in a Bunkie for a good night's sleep, and a hearty breakfast, before heading out to your remote drop off.

The Prey will be required to travel 25 kilometres over the day, and will be equipped with a map, compass, radio (For emergencies only) and food. The prey is required to bring there own Back Pack, and gear (boots, clothing etc.).

The Man Tracker will be provided a horse, food, saddlebags for personal belongings, and an experienced horseperson knowledgeable about the area for the horse's abilities.

The Preys object is to make it to there destination by 6:00 p.m.
The Man Trackers object is to catch the Prey before they make it to there destination.

Winners receive a Man Tracker Trophy.

Bushwhacking Adventures

Due to requests form our regulars; I am introducing a "Marion Ride" for 2009.

This ride will take you to some of my favourite riding spots. Each day will be a new location. With the exception of the first and last day, your adventures will not only be visiting interesting sights and enjoying groomed trails, but we will be venturing off of the beaten paths to check out smaller less used trails, and making new trails of our own to get to our predetermined destination.

This ride is for those who have a great sense of humor and trust both me and my horses, as we laugh our way through the trails, when I make a wrong turn; and admire the horses for how well they can maneuver through the bushes, and rough terrain.

Not to worry though we will have a compass, GPS, radio, cell phone and Map of the area.

Ride is six days of riding, six night's accommodation with the use of the swimming pool and Hot Tub to relax in at the end of the night.

Duration in the saddle daily: average 6 hours per day.

Includes: All meals, guide, horses, all you need to bring is your personal items and a SMILE.

B & B Cost: \$1,000.00 per person.

Bunkie: \$800.00 per person (Sleeping in our Bunkie's; sleeping bag is required)

September 27 – October 3, 2009

On this ride you will be traveling over 100 miles in our scenic Grey County.

After the ride you will receive a certificate for your accomplishment of staying in the saddle.

This is a ride that most people dream about doing, but aren't sure if they are ready. If you enjoy horses, like to have fun, and like to be pampered this ride will be one of your best vacations.

Ride includes five full days of riding and six nights in Bed & Breakfasts along the trails. You will arrive on Sunday evening at 7:00 p.m and leave on Saturday morning after breakfast. Daily meals include breakfast at B & B, scenic picnic lunches along the trail, and dinner at local restaurants or at the Bed & Breakfast.

On the first day you will ride southeast towards Dundalk from the Whinny Acres farm, before starting northwest to Owensound where you will finish your ride on Friday. Then the riders and horses will be transported back to Whinny Acres for a farewell dinner and social evening.

On this ride you will be able to canter in open trails, have many River crossings, spectacular views, swim with your horse and explore both Grey and Saugeen Forests along the route.

Truly one of the best ways to see what beautiful country Ontario has to offer.
