

## Adventure Horseback Riding Directions & Map

*IMPORTANT: You must REGISTER for a date with the Office at 416-898-3573 or by using the Online Registration form. We do not accept walk in's/show ups as our space is very limited.*

Your tour operator for this trip will be "Whinny Acres", named after their frequent horse calls that can be heard across the plains of the farm which is located in Priceville, Ontario.

### What to wear:

Please try to arrive at least 20-30 minutes prior to the start of your ride to allow us to get you ready and geared up and have the ride leave on time. We do provide helmets so you don't have to worry about this, unless you have your own. We do ask that you come dressed for the weather. For your lower body, best attire to wear in the Spring/Summer/Fall months are jeans and in the Winter months are snow-pants or jeans with a layer underneath for added warmth. Hiking boots are greatly recommended or other boot type shoes suitable for riding. In the warmer weather running shoes are acceptable. For your upper body you can dress according to weather conditions, however it is a good idea to dress in layers as it will allow you to remove articles of clothing as you get too warm and zip up when you get cold. Basically dress warm and comfortable. If you are planning on driving home after the trip it is a good idea to bring a change on clothes to make your drive more comfortable (sometime less horse smelly :).

### Whinny Acres is located:

- 45 minutes from Guelph
- 60 minutes from Milton
- 90 minutes from the Toronto airport
- 120 minutes from Hamilton
- 180 minutes from the Niagara border and London, Ontario

### Driving directions from all of the above cities are as follows:

**From Toronto:** Take Hwy # 400, Airport Rd, or Hwy # 10 north to Hwy # 9. Go west to Orangeville, where you will turn northwest onto Highway # 10.

Take Highway # 10 to Flesherton, where you will turn left ( south) onto #4, travel 7 kilometers, then turn left, (south) onto Artemesia Glenelg Townline Road, travel 1 kilometer, make the first left (east) onto Southline "A" road, we are the second driveway on your right. .

**From London, Ontario:** Take the 401 east to Highway # 6 north into Guelph. Follow #6 into Arthur. Turn right (northeast) onto #14. Take this road, driving through Hopeville, then watch for an "S" bend in the road. After you go through the "S" bend in the road, you will make the first left (west) onto our road - Southline "A". We are located 2 kilometers on the left side (bottom of second hill).

**From Kitchener/ Waterloo:** Take Highway # 86 north to #12, where you will turn right (north). This road will take you into Arthur, where you will turn left (northwest) onto Highway # 6, Then less than  $\frac{1}{2}$  kilometer Turn right (northeast) onto # 14. Take this road, driving through Hopeville, then watch for an "S" bend in the road. After you go through the "S" bend in the road, you will make the first left (west) onto our road - Southline "A". We are located 2 kilometers on the left side (bottom of second hill).

**From Hamilton:** Take Highway # 6 north, pass over the 401, through Guelph and into Arthur. Turn right (northeast) onto # 14. Take this road, driving through Hopeville, then watch for an "S" bend in the road. After you go through the "S" bend in the road, you will make the first left (west) onto our road - Southline "A". We are located 2 kilometers on the left side (bottom of second hill).

**From Niagara:** Take the QEW into Hamilton, where you will turn north onto #6 highway. Then take the directions from Hamilton.

**From Guelph:** Take Highway # 6 into Arthur. Turn right (northeast) onto # 14. Take this road, driving through Hopeville, then watch for an "S" bend in the road. After you go through the "S" bend in the road, you will make the first left (west) onto our road - Southline "A". We are located 2 kilometers on the left side (bottom of second hill).

**From Milton/Rockwood:** Take Highway # 25 north to Highway # I24, Turn left ( west) travel @ 4 kilometers, turn right (north) on highway # 26. This road will take you into Belwood Lake. Then turn left (west) onto # 19, then turn right (north) onto #16. Take this road to the end, at Highway # 89, where you will make a short left (west). Less than  $\frac{1}{2}$  a kilometer, you will turn right (north) on Concession # 11. This road turns into Grey road #14 (so DO NOT TURN). Take this road, driving through Hopeville, then watch for an "S" bend in the road. After you go through the "S" bend in the road, you will make the first left (west) onto our road - Southline "A". We are located 2 kilometers on the left side (bottom of second hill).

The potential for other participant(s) to act in a negligent manner that might contribute to injury to themselves or others, such as failing to act within their ability or to maintain control over an equine.
- 3.) **I Freely Accept and Fully Assume All Responsibility** for inherent "**RISKS**". And possibilities of personal injury, death, property damage or loss resulting from my Participation in Equine Activities.
- 4.) **I Acknowledge** that it remains **my Sole Responsibility** to act in such a manner as to be responsible for my own safety and to Participate Within My Own Limits.
- 5.) **In addition to consideration given for my Participation in Equine Activities, I and my heirs, executors, administrators and assigns**.
